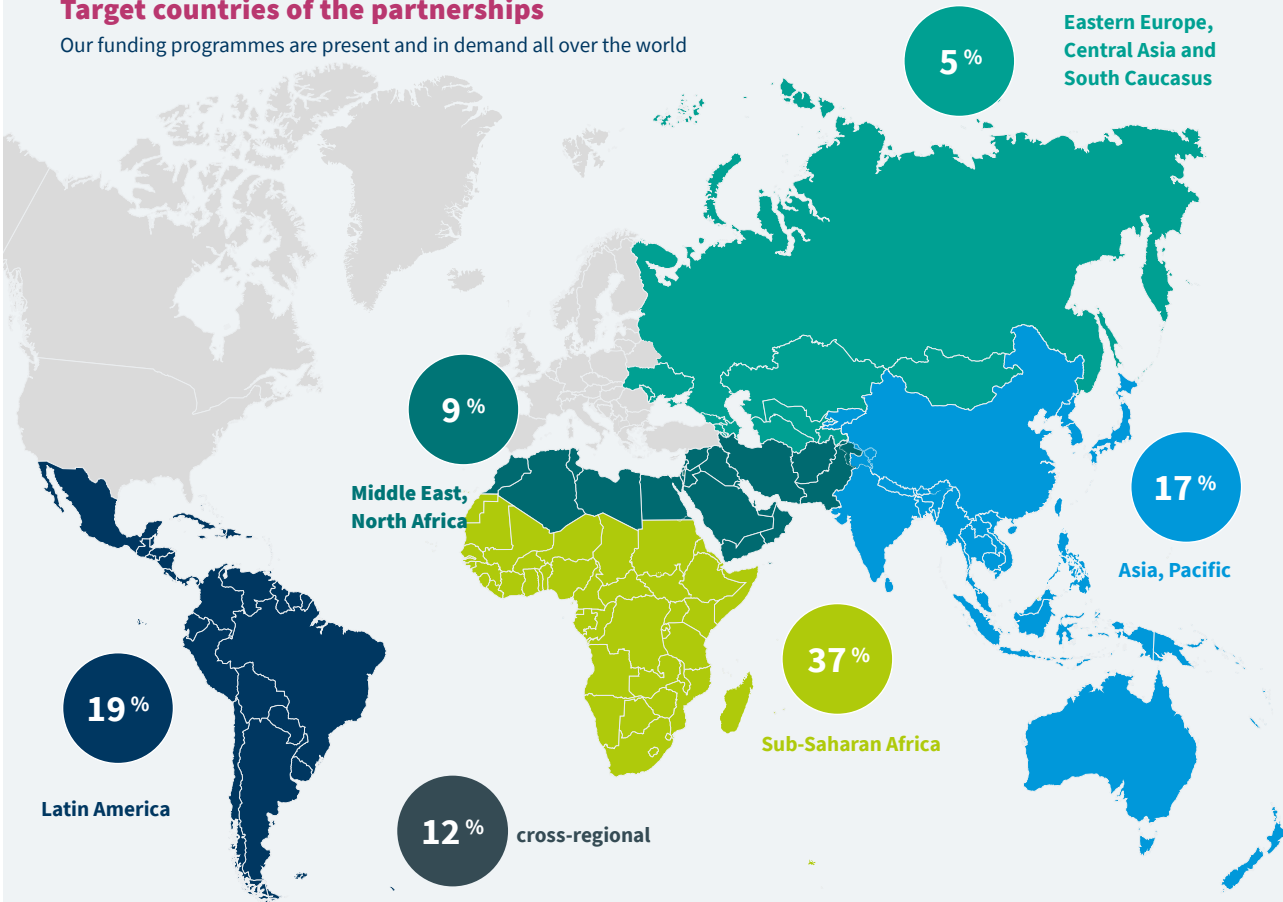

Target countries of the partnerships

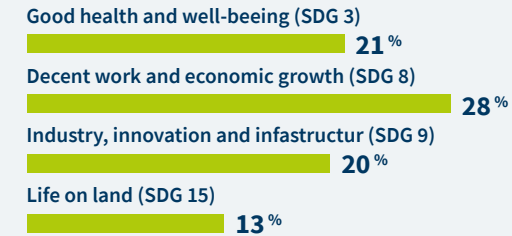
Our funding programmes are present and in demand all over the world

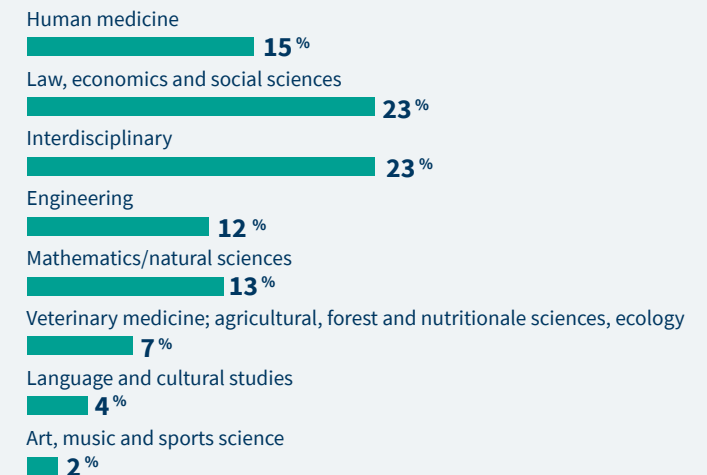
Networks in the Global South

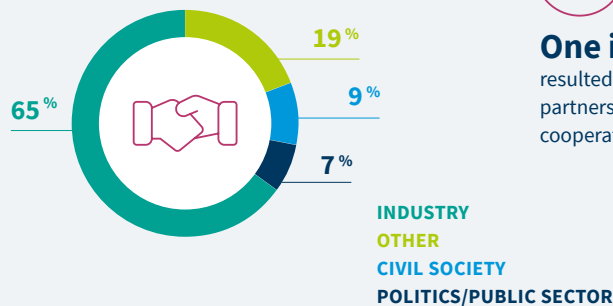


Focus on practical application

Composition of partners



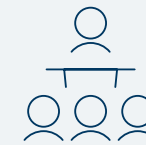
One in three projects resulted in new contacts with business partners who are actively involved in the cooperation

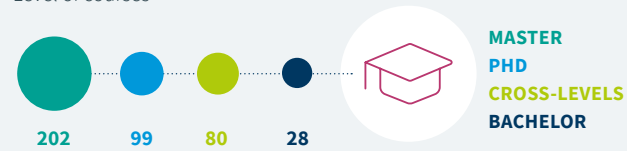
courses have been developed or revised since 2016.
