Design and implementation of a joint COIL teaching project in the summer semester 2023 between the TU Dresden and the WUNU, involving the colleagues trained in 2022.


- (1) Joint case study design on the topic "Marshall plan for the restructuring and digitalization of higher education in Ukraine".




