Background

The idea of establishing an East African-German University of Applied Sciences is based on the objective to offer practice-oriented study programs with a strong focus on linkages between higher education and industry. In order to prepare this binational project, German universities of applied sciences have carried out a variety of capacity building and networking measures since October 2017, ranging from delegation visits and workshops to the establishment of large networks between Kenyan and German HEIs as well as with the private sector.
