PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

“Higher Education Dialogue with Western Balkan Countries” – this DAAD programme supports German higher education institutions in strengthening their contacts with universities in the countries of the Western Balkans. Academic exchange in the form of workshops, meetings, seminars, study trips, summer schools and conferences is often the starting point for more far-reaching developments. It contributes to the reduction of ethnic conflicts and to the support of civil society. Together with their partner institutions, German universities continue to develop teaching and research, support students and young academics, and intensify cross-border cooperation.



Funding is provided for

- Dialogue formats such as workshops, meetings, seminars, study visits, summer schools or conferences (personnel resources for project management and support, travel funds, accommodation funds, material resources for the planning, implementation and follow-up of events)
- Short-term scholarships and guest residencies for study, teaching or research stays in Germany or at the partner institutions abroad (up to two scholarships, in connection to the topic of the event above)

Eligible applicants are state and state-recognised German universities and non-university research institutions based in Germany.

TARGET REGIONS

Partner countries: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia

Other countries from which participants can be included in the activities: Bulgaria, Greece, Hungary, Moldova, Romania, Slovenia, Turkey and Ukraine.
