



Green Mobility Top Up **(Support for climate-friendly travel)**

The DAAD offers scholarship holders in selected funding programmes the opportunity to apply for a **Green Mobility Top Up** of **at least 50 euros** for climate-friendly travel where the DAAD-funded journey (outward and/or return journey) **was completed in full using climate-friendly means of transport**. It is important that the entire route from the country of origin to the destination country was completed with climate-friendly means of transport. It is not permissible to apply for the top up only for partial routes. An application for this top up can be submitted once in relation to the outward journey and once in relation to the return journey. The Green Mobility Top Up can only be applied for if you are entitled to a travel allowance as part of the scholarship.

Climate-friendly means of transport:

The following are accepted as climate-friendly means of transport in terms of the Green Mobility Top Up:

- **Train**
- **Bus/long-distance bus**
- **Ship** (only in connection with train/bus; such as by ferry from Greece to Italy and from Italy to Germany by train)

The Green Mobility Top Up cannot however be paid for journeys and parts of a journey that are covered by car (including a shared car).

The amount of the Green Mobility Top Up depends on the country from which you applied for funding or for German scholarship holders on the destination country and is **a minimum of 50 euros**. The exact level of the Green Mobility Top Up can be found in the following list:
