

How to apply for a DAAD scholarship FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

1. How can I apply via the DAAD Portal?

2. Who can help me if I have a technical question?

4. How can I find study programmes at German universities?

The website <https://www.hochschulkompass.de/en/study-in-germany.html> gives you an overview about almost all study programmes in Germany. **Attention:** DAAD doesn't cover for study programmes that are subject to charges. At all universities in the German region Baden-Württemberg, internationals must pay a fee of 1.500,00 EUR per semester. Therefore, we would advise you to look carefully and focus on the various free study programmes in Germany.

5. How can I find out if I meet the requirements to be accepted to my preferred study programme?

It's important that you can meet the requirements for the study programme(s) that you indicate in your scholarship application. Please consult the website of the chosen faculty to learn about the requirements. If necessary, please contact the International Office of the university.

6. How can I find out if my university degree qualifies to be accepted to a master's programme in Germany?

To be accepted to a master's programme in Germany, you must provide a university degree that relates to a European bachelor. Please enter your university degree in the search bar on the following page to find out if it is equivalent to a bachelor:
