WHO CAN APPLY?

The target group for scholarships are graduates and postgraduates from Sub-Saharan Africa with a first academic degree if applying for a Master programme, or with a Master degree if applying for a doctoral programme who want to pursue Master's or PhD courses in their home country / with a residence permit (so called In-Country scholarships) or in another Sub-Saharan African country / without a residence permit (In-Region scholarships).

Please note that South African (ZA) students cannot apply for In-Country scholarships through this programme tender. In-Country students from South Africa (ZA) can apply through the NRF/DAAD scholarship programme.

Female applicants and candidates from less privileged regions or groups are especially encouraged to participate in the programme!

WHAT KIND OF DEGREE PROGRAMMES ARE OFFERED?

Scholarships are available for Master and PhD courses at selected institutions in Malawi, Namibia and South Africa for a wide range of disciplines, including:

Aquaculture and Fisheries Science; Computer Science; Urban Studies - Southern Urbanism; Development Studies at ISD; Molecular Biology and Human Genetics.
