- Funding period: 2022 to 2024
- Programme Objectives
 - Implementation of virtual courses as part of degree programmes at Ukrainian universities to maintain the curricula
 - Involvement of (refugee) lecturers from Ukrainian universities
 - Competences of teachers at Ukrainian universities to develop further virtual courses/study programmes are built up

Funding in total: **22,6 Mio. Euro**

- Topics of the training courses for lecturers at Ukrainian universities to build up **expertise** for the development of further virtual courses/study programmes:
 - Tools and applications for digital teaching (e.g. collaboration tools, gamification and virtual reality applications)
 - Creation and needs-based adaptation of digital learning materials (e.g. use of open educational resources)
 - Didactics and methods for (a-)synchronous, competence-orientated online formats and digital examinations
 - Specialised didactic skills (e.g. use of virtual patients, integrated urban planning, language teaching in digital format)

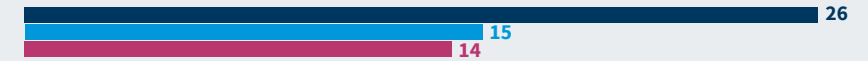
