InklusU is a transnational university with a holistic approach to inclusion in the areas of:

1. Access and participation: esp. for students from vulnerable target groups
2. Governance: through the integration of students, staff and stakeholders in the strategy and management of the alliance
3. Internationalization: by providing opportunities for an international experience for less mobile students and staff
4. Knowledge production and sharing: promoting interdisciplinary, participatory research and open access

5. Outreach: promoting exchanges between universities and local communities in Europe.

The InklusU Alliance strengthens collaboration among the seven partner universities in the areas of teaching, research, administration and community engagement. It uses innovative didactic and research-oriented approaches such as challenge-based learning, opens up to new technologies in teaching, including an avatar-based virtual campus, optimizes the (digital) management of internationalization, and builds long-term relationships with society.
