Vision of ECIU

Instead of fixed degrees, the ECIU University focuses on developing qualifications according to individual needs and interests.

Priorities and Project Activities

- Implementation of a separate competence centre for "Challenge-Based Learning (C³BL)": Establishment and development of consultation and further education qualification offers for all participants within the framework of Challenge-based-education (CBE)
- Development of a real and virtual networking platform for teachers, learners and other stakeholders to exchange experiences and knowledge on CBE
- Creation of incentive schemes for teaching staff to participate in the cross-university development of innovation-driven and research-related teaching offers, especially with digital components supported by physical and virtual mobilities for the participation in working meetings
- Public relations work (e.g. website, information events, interview series, publications, conference) to strengthen the project's visibility both within and outside the university



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
