This vision is implemented through various measures, including:

- **Development** of forward-looking and sustainable teaching formats, called '**Connected Communities**' with the goal of establishing these collaborative teaching activities as integral components in the educational offerings portfolio at TUD.
- **Support for early career researchers** in enhancing their competencies to assume leadership roles and effectively communicate their contributions to addressing global challenges. This brings us closer to the long-term objective of establishing a '**EUTOPIA interuniversity campus** for early career researchers' and a **EUTOPIA Global Institute** for the joint development of solutions to global challenges.
