Priorities and Project Activities

- Digitisation of academic courses and design of joint online platforms: Teaching and service offers are accessible online for the entire network, innovative formats are developed, administrative processes are simplified.
- Multilingualism: promotion of language offerings in all languages of the network, from German courses for students and staff of our partners to innovative online formats and language tests; development of a common language policy.
- Diversity: Promotion of diversity competence, online and in face-to-face courses for all status groups.
- Workshops and job shadowing for administration and management to exchange experiences in all areas.
- Mobility: Promoting the mobility of teaching staff, researchers and management, administrative and technical staff throughout the network; establishing a YUFE Mobility Award to realise short-term stays and initiate joint research projects.
