Priorities and Project Activities

This should also contribute to raising awareness of intercultural communication, particularly in the digital teaching/learning environment.
- The **further development and introduction of standardised and transparent digitalised processes for student exchanges** between the partner universities will be pursued, thus facilitating the administration of student mobility.
