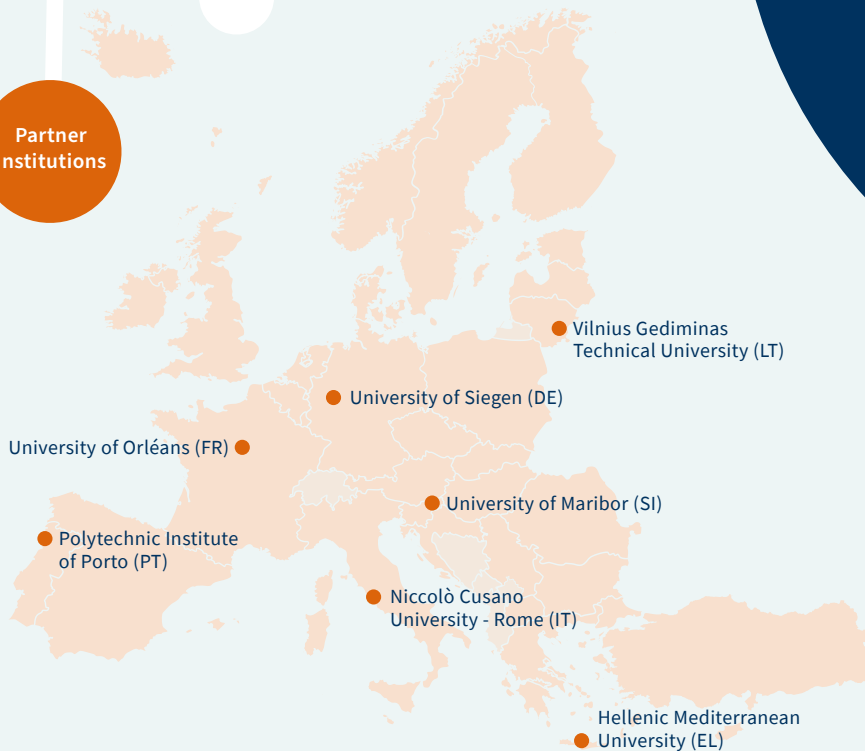

Priorities and Project Activities

- **Internationalization of study programmes and mobility offers:** Increase the amount of foreign language speaking courses. Development of high-grade qualification offers with integrated physical and virtual mobility for lecturers and students that leads to a European joint ATHENA degree
- **Strengthen international research:** Implementation of summer schools for researchers of the partner institutions. Establishing links to industry and strengthen the innovation potential with assistance of the Centre for Sensor Systems at University of Siegen
- **Strengthen administrative coordination and cooperation in the alliance:** Cooperation with and among the administrative units of the member universities will be fostered towards european cooperation. Advisory services will be offered to learn from other European networks in student data portability and visibility strategies. Data standards like EMREX and EWP will be incorporated to further develop a secure student data exchange
